SUMMER SCHOOL OFFERINGS

Two sessions will be offered, with each session lasting three weeks. Summer school is limited to students who have failed a course or who are behind on credits.

Parents and students are reminded that students who fail either semester of a year-long Mathematics course that is required for graduation must repeat the entire course. If a student fails either semester of an English or Science course, they must make up the failed semester. All failed courses should be made up during the following school year. **However, students can make up the failed semester(s) by attending one or both of the three week sessions of summer school.**

TO THE PARENTS OF ATHLETES IN BELVIDERE SCHOOLS

All students in middle school and high school who are planning to be involved in athletics MUST have their sports physicals prior to any participation. This means no student will be allowed to try out or participate in any sport unless a physical exam is completed and turned into the Athletic Director's office at the high school. This sports physical can reveal medical problems such as heart murmurs, high blood pressure, or other serious conditions that need to be treated before a student participates in a sport. Sports physicals are good for one year from the date they are done. Having a physical done over the summer will allow the student to participate in any sport throughout the school year.

- ❖ All immunizations must be up to date prior to the 1st day of school – **August 18, 2010**.

AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT NEWS

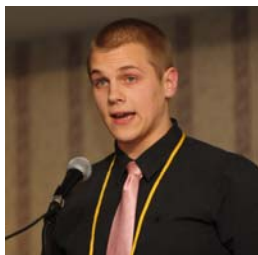
