

DIRECTIONS

Belvidere South Middle School:

Take Beloit Road south to Belvidere Road (Shopko). Turn left and stay on for 4.5 miles. Turn west (right) on East 6th Avenue. Go about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile until you get to the middle school located on the left side of the road. (919 E. Sixth Street, Belvidere)

Boylan High School:

Take Springcreek Road towards Rockford to Riverside Drive. Follow Riverside Drive into Rockford and cross over the Rock River. Go past Riverside Drive/North Main intersection and turn right at the next stoplight (Huffman Boulevard). Huffman Boulevard will curve around to the football field.

Burlington Central Middle School:

Games are played at old Burlington Central High School. Take Genoa Road to Genoa. Pick up Route #72 going straight out of Genoa. About 2 miles past a large "S" curve; Walker Road crosses Route #72. Turn right onto Walker Road. Walker Road goes into Burlington and becomes Burlington Road. Continue on Burlington Road to Plato Road and turn left. Continue on to junior high. (444W303 Plato Road, Burlington)

Burlington Prairie Knolls: Take Genoa Road to Genoa. At Rt. 72 (stop sign after going under viaduct and passing the school) turn left and proceed through downtown Genoa. Stay on 72E to Rt. 47. (More than 2 roads intersect at this point.) Cross over 47; it becomes Rt. 20. Follow Rt. 20 to Nesler Road and turn right. Prairie Knolls is on the left side of Nesler, beyond a church and a group of houses. (225 Nesler Road, Elgin, IL 60124)

Byron Forest Preserve:

Take Route 20 to Rt. 2 South. At stoplight of Rt. 2 and 72 Junction, turn left. Go across bridge to first stoplight and turn right. Go 1/2 mile to entrance of forest preserve on left. Runners start race at South Shelter - located top of hill from entrance, across from Observatory.

Byron High School:

Take Route 20 out of Belvidere and continue toward Freeport. Take Dixon exit south for Route 2. Travel on Rt. 2 into Byron until the second stoplight. This will be Colfax/Tower. Go right and travel past the Middle School (on your right), High School is further down on the left. (696 N. Colfax St., Byron, IL 61010)

Byron Middle School:

Take Route 20 out of Belvidere and continue toward Freeport. Take Dixon exit south for Route 2. Travel on Rt. 2 into Byron until the second stoplight. This will be Colfax/Tower. Go right and travel 2 1/2 blocks. The old middle school will be on your right. Continue past, cross the railroad tracks, and the school is on the left.

Dekalb High School:

Take Annie Glidden Road through Dekalb (cross Route #38) to stop sign (Taylor Road.). Turn left and go to 4th Street and turn right. High school is on right about 1/4 mile (next to Eagle Shopping Plaza). (1515 S. 4th St., zip 60115)

DeKalb Clinton Rosette Middle School:

Take Annie Glidden Road to 64. Turn left on 64. Go to First Street and turn right. Go approximately 8 miles and school is on the left. (650 N. First St., Dekalb)

Dekalb Huntley Middle School:

Take Annie Glidden Road to Dekalb, continue past university and on through town. Just outside of town turn left on Taylor Street. School is 4 to 5 minutes away on right side of road. (821 South 7th Street, DeKalb)

Freeport Middle School:

Take Route #20 into Freeport. Just as you enter Freeport, the road splits to the right. Go straight (belt line). Stay on belt line for 3-4 minutes, going past a couple of car dealerships. Look for an insurance company building on the right side. Just past the building and just before the gas station, turn right. Go several blocks through residential section until you see the high school and stadium. Turn left at stadium. Middle School is the big building on the left side of street. High School is on right. (701 W. Empire Street, Freeport)

Harlem High School:

Take your favorite route into Rockford to Alpine Road & Riverside Road and go north on Alpine Road. Continue north on Alpine Road into Loves Park. Harlem high school will be on your right. The track is located behind the school.

Harlem Middle School:

Games will be played at old Harlem South High School on Windsor Road. Take your favorite route to Alpine Road and Riverside Road and go north on Alpine Road. Just after Forest Hills Road exchange, you will turn left on Windsor Road. School will be about two miles on left. (735 Windsor St., Loves Park)

Highland Community College:

Take Highway 20 to Freeport. Turn left on Empire. Take Empire all the way to Highland Community College.

Johnsburg Junior High School:

Take IL Rt. 76 to Woodstock Road and turn right. Woodstock road "t's" into Grange Hall Road; turn left, but only for .3 mile, Woodstock Road continues east to the right. Follow Woodstock Road for 15 miles to South Hughes Road and turn left. Continue for 3.3 miles, and turn right onto Nelson Road. Follow Nelson Road for 2 miles and turn right onto Charles Road. Charles Road becomes IL-120 after 4 miles. Stay on this road/highway for approximately 5 miles to Ringwood Road and turn left. After another 3 miles, turn right onto IL-31. Follow IL-31 for approximately 2 miles, and turn left onto W. Johnsburg Road. After traveling approximately 1-1/2 miles, turn left onto St. Johns Avenue, and then right onto Church Street. The school's address is 2220 Church Avenue.

Marengo Middle School:

Take Route 20 to Marengo. Go straight at the Route 23 intersection. Continue on Route 20 a few blocks to Locust Street (a small bank is on the corner) and turn right. School is just down the block on Locust Street. (539 W. Locust St., Marengo)

Oregon/Blackhawk Wrestling Center & Oregon High School & Track:

Take I-39 south to Hwy #64 to Oregon. Stay on Hwy #64 through last stoplight until you arrive at 10th St. Turn left on 10th St. At the first stop sign (Jefferson St.) turn right. Blackhawk Center is on the backside of the high school, immediately after you turn onto Jefferson St. (1101 Jefferson St., Oregon). *Oregon High School track shares same parking lot - address is 210 S. 10th Street, Oregon.*

Oregon Jr. High, Mt. Morris, IL:

Take Hwy. 20 to Hwy. 2 south to Mud Creed Road (just after Silver Ridge Golf Course). Follow Mud Creek to Mt. Morris. Turn right on Hwy. 64 and follow to McKendrie Rd. Turn left on McKendrie and follow to Brayton Rd. Turn right on Brayton. School is about 2 blocks down on Brayton.

Rochelle High School:

Take I-39 south, exit on Rt. 38 to Rochelle. High School will be to your right off Rt. 38.

Rochelle Middle School:

Take I-39 south, exit on Rt. 38 to Rochelle. Go 1.5 miles to Caron Road and turn left. Go 0.2 miles to School Avenue and turn right. School is 1 block on left side of street. (111 School Avenue, Rochelle)

Roscoe Middle School:

Take Caledonia Road north past Hwy 173 to Elevator Road. Turn left on Elevator. Middle school is on the left just on the edge of town. (6121 Elevator Road, Roscoe)

St. Charles Wredling Middle School:

Take I-90 to Rt. 31, go south. Go through Elgin to St. Charles, turn right at the stoplight (Rt. 64.). Go to 7th Street (there is a school but it is not Wredling) and turn left. Go to the first street you can turn right on, Indiana Street. The street dead-ends into Wredling School. (255 Redgate Road, St. Charles)

Stephen Mack Middle School:

Take Beloit Road North - cross Rt. 173, and continue into Roscoe. Cross the main street and continue to the stop light at Rt. 251. Cross Rt. 251, and turn right onto Old River Road. The school address is 11810 Old River Road, on the left.

Sterling Middle School:

Take Hwy 2 to Sterling, going past Farm & Fleet and Wolohan Lumber. Turn right on the 1st road past Wolohan Lumber. This will be a 4-lane road. Go through 2 stop signs; turn left at the 3rd stop sign. This should put you on 6th Avenue. Jr. High is the first school building on the left (about 3 blocks).

Sycamore High School:

Take Genoa Road south to Genoa. Turn left at the stop sign after the middle school. That is the main street through Genoa. Turn right at Hwy 23 (McDonalds is on the corner.). Continue past the Sycamore Jr. High on Hwy 23 going through the business district and 2 blocks of residential homes. Hwy. 23 goes left, stay on Hwy 23. Go to the 2nd stoplight (555 Spartan Trail, zip 60178) and turn right.

Sycamore Middle School:

Take Genoa Road south to Genoa. Turn left at the stop sign after the middle school. That is the main street through Genoa. Travel through Genoa to Highway #23. Turn right on Route #23 at McDonalds. The junior high is on the right side of the highway just before you get into Sycamore. The turn (look following Peace/Plank Road stoplight) is easy to miss because of a small grove of trees hiding the building as you approach. (150 Maplewood Drive, Sycamore)

Sycamore Park District Complex: Take Genoa Road South through Genoa. (Make a left turn at the stop sign after going under the viaduct and past the middle school.) Turn right at IL-23 (there is a McDonald's at the corner). Travel 7.5 miles, and turn left at the stop light at E. State Street in Sycamore, which is IL-64 . Travel approximately 1.5 miles and turn right onto Airport Road, which is the complex.

Winnebago Fuller Forest Preserve:

Take Highway 20 to Rt. 2. Turn south on Rt. 2. Turn north on Meridian Road. Forest preserve is on the right side (Fitzgerald Road).

Woodstock Creekside:

Take Poplar Grove Road to Woodstock Road. Turn right; follow Woodstock Road; it becomes Kishwaukee Valley Road. At Route 14 (stop light), turn right. Go to Dean Street (stop light) and make another right. Travel for about 1 mile to the entry for Apple Creek Estates. Take the left turn lane into Apple Creek Estates. This is Hercules Road; it winds through the subdivision. The school is on the right side; enter at the first driveway.

Woodstock Northwood:

Take Highway #20 East to Marengo. Go left on Highway #23 for about 1 mile until you hit Route #176. Take Route #176 east to Route #47. Continue on Route #47 heading toward Lake Geneva. Northwood will be the last building on the left as you leave town. It will be across from the courthouse. (2121 Seminary Rd., Woodstock)

Woodstock Olson - Emerickson Park:

Take Highway #20 east to Marengo. Go left on Highway #23 for about 1 mile until you hit Route #176. Take Route #176 east until you hit Route #47. Go north on Rt. 47 to Rt. 14. Go west on Rt. 14 three or four miles until you hit Kishwaukee Valley Road. Take a right on Kishwaukee, go about 1 mile to Emerickson Park. Turn left into park. Go up the hill by tennis courts / old pool area for cross country meet.
