On February 6, 2006, The National Domestic Violence Hotline and Liz Claiborne, Inc. announced the start of **loveisrespect.org** and the National Teen Dating Abuse Hotline (NTDAH). This is a web-based and telephone-based hotline for teens (ages 13-18) regarding dating violence.

Trained advocates are available on the hotline 24/7 to provide confidential support and information about resources. One-on-one live chat is also available via the website from 4:00pm to midnight, Central Standard Time. In addition to this service, the website provides dating abuse information for teens, parents, friends and other concerned individuals.
